City promotes policeman to investigator

Hermitage policeman Todd A. Saylor was promoted Thursday by city commissioners to criminal investigator, replacing the retired John Piatek. He was recommended for the job by Hermitage Civil Service Commission and Police Chief Patrick B. McElhinny.

Saylor is a graduate of Grove City High School and the University of Pittsburgh, where he received a bachelor's degree in administration of justice. He also was an honors graduate of the Municipal Police Academy at the Indiana University of Pennsylvania.

Saylor has served in Hermitage since Oct. 4, 1999, and has training in interview and interrogation, evidence, search and seizure and basic criminal investigation.

Saylor, who is married and has two children, received a life-saving commendation in 2009 for using a defibrillator.
