

ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

A sealed bid for installation of electronic automatic handicap accessible door operators at the **Community Counseling Center of Mercer County (CCC)** building will be received by CCC, 2201 East State Street, Hermitage, PA 16148 until **11:00am prevailing time, Thursday, September 9th, 2010** at which time they will be publically opened and read aloud.

The work for this project will include, but not limited to, purchase and installation of electronic automatic handicapped accessible door operators on existing external doors at two entrances (4 doors total-Room Vestibules 121 and 151) of the facility. Provide wireless control access at each door (4 total). Verify infield locations. Add all necessary electric to install devices and enhance ADA capability.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Bond in the amount of not less than 10% of the total bid. A 100% Performance & Payment Bond is required for this work.

All bids shall be irrevocable for 60 days after the bid opening date unless award is delayed by a required approval of another government agency, the sale of bonds, or award of the grant or grants, in which case this Bid shall remain subject to acceptance for 120 days after the bid opening date provided the Act of November 26, 1978 (P.L. 1309, No. 317), as amended by the Act of December 12, 1994 (P.L. 1042, No. 142)

Prevailing wages established under the Davis-Bacon Act will apply to this contract. The contract documents contain requirements for addressing prevailing labor wages, labor standards, non-discrimination in hiring practices, goals for minority and female participation, MBA and WBE participation, participation by Section 3 residents and businesses, and related matter.

CCC welcomes proposals from small, minority and women business enterprises and individual minority and women professionals. Attention is called to the fact the employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

CCC reserves the right to waive any defects, errors, omissions, mistakes, informalities, to accept any bid or combination of bids that are deemed to be in the best interest of CCC, and to reject any or all proposals.
