**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HERMITAGE,
MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING
CERTAIN FEES AND REMOVING CERTAIN FEES IN THE
CITY OF HERMITAGE SCHEDULE OF FEES, AS
PROVIDED BY RESOLUTION 5-2000, AS AMENDED.**

WHEREAS, the City of Hermitage has adopted a fee schedule establishing fees for the filing of applications, permits, licenses, equipment use, and certain services, including providing certifications and copies of certain documents as authorized by Resolution 5-2000, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hermitage desires to amend the fee schedule to increase the amount of certain fees and to remove certain fees that are no longer applicable.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF HERMITAGE, MERCER
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND HERMITAGE HEREBY RESOLVES
THROUGH AUTHORITY OF THE SAME AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The fee schedule established by Resolution 5-2000, as amended, is amended to provide the following changes in existing fees:

Type of Fee	Amount
Copy of Traffic Accident Report	<u>\$15.00</u>
Return Check Charge	<u>\$40.00</u>
Duplicate Real Estate Tax Bill	<u>For the first two - \$5.00 each</u> <u>For the third and above - \$10.00 each</u>
Liquor License Transfer Application	<u>\$1,000.00</u>
Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment	<u>\$500.00</u>
Board of Appeals Hearing	<u>\$350.00</u>
Fire Lane Parking Violation	<u>\$25.00</u>

Section 2. The fee schedule established by Resolution 5-2000 is amended to remove the following fees that are no longer applicable:

Type of Fee	Amount
Fire Code Appeals Board Hearing	\$125.00
Gas or Oil Well Drilling Permit Fee	\$250.00
Copy of Traffic Accident Report (resident)	\$5.00

Section 3. All other fees established under the Schedule of Fees, Resolution 5-2000, as amended, are unchanged and remain in effect.
