Hermitage2030: A Comprehensive Plan Update

Hermitage, PA, March 13, 2018: The City of Hermitage has launched an online survey as part of an outreach effort to involve the public in the first update of the City's comprehensive plan since 1993. The comprehensive plan update, which kicked off in October 2017, will provide City officials with a blueprint to guide decision making during the next 10 to 20 years. The plan will address future land use and zoning implications, housing needs, economic development, transportation issues, natural resources and agricultural preservation and parks and recreation. The City hired Mackin Engineering to facilitate the plan and anticipates its completion by the end of 2018.
